Committee Reports / Assignment Updates / General Questions

Scholarship - Brooks Burr

• Brooks discussed the current process for awarding scholarships from the Staff Association. This process has been discussed many times and he felt that the process needs to be revamped. Our first priority is to award funds to a non-traditional part-time staff member or student; however, sometimes it is difficult to find someone who meets that criteria. The next option is to award it to a non-traditional full-time staff member or student. We need to come up with a better solution for awarding funds. The awards are very beneficial to the recipients. Once everything is in place, staff members need to be aware of any changes made.

Welcome & Staff Mentoring – Chris Gifford

- Chris mentioned that we received great support from Human Resources. It has been great
 getting to know people on campus and it helps our new employees too. He kept a list of
 employees who were willing to meet and greet new employees each month. Apparently, we
 now have access to NeoEd and can sign up to volunteer on campus. Volunteers receive a
 reminder about their assignment too. Chris mentioned that he is willing to help the new chair
 of this committee.
- New employees are given a coupon for a free drink along with some swag. It was suggested
 that maybe the group who welcomes a new employee could setup a date to meet again to talk
 about any concerns or suggestions that they might have. This also helps to continue the
 welcome.

Events - Chewi Lockhart

- Chewi mentioned that during his events, he had everyone in attendance put their name and ID
 number on an index card, which he used to trace the number of people attending. This helped
 him calculate how many people need to be fed at future events. He will give this information to
 Wendi for next year.
- He mentioned that using Chick-Fil a is a cheaper option; however, there is no variety in the food and they don't have anything for dietary restrictions. Therefore, Dining Services has more food options and they can meet dietary restrictions.
- Chewi mentioned that people like to receive free stuff and those items do not need to be expensive. It is a positive thing to add to events.

Awards & Recognition – Deb Millet

• Deb mentioned that this year was the first time that we gave awards and money to recipients from the four divisions on campus. They are annual awards and are no longer given by

- semester. Jon felt that this will continue in the future. Wide spread nominations from across campus needs to encouraged, especially from directors or supervisors.
- Jon felt that in the future, board members should not be nominated for these awards.
- Regarding Mini-Trailblazers awards, it was suggested to add a few specific questions to the criteria for nominations, just like we have for our annual awards. This would alleviate silly or poor nominations. The board agreed with this suggestion.

Legislative - Jon for Riley McMullin

• Jon has appreciated Riley's help on this committee. He has a good relationship with Henrie Walton and would like him to continue in this role to keep the lines of communication open.

Health & Wellness - Anilee Adams

Anilee mentioned that her committee has been great to work with, they follow through well.
 Last year stopped a lot of activities; therefore, she hopes that there will be more activities next
 year. There are some tried and true events that were very successful and well attended.
 Therefore, she would like to see those continue. They were the step challenge, food
 demonstrations with April Ashcroft, and March Madness. PEHP has a lot of great incentives
 too.

Professional Development – Megan Church

 The presentations that we had were well attended. She felt that the committee should look for fun ways to get people to attend these events. She mentioned possibly getting presenters to come here from off campus. Jon mentioned that we should make these events quality, not quantity, which means that we hold them once or twice a semester.

Service - Allie White

- Allie mentioned that fall semester was rough; however, spring was better. She likes the idea of
 piggy-backing off of other events on campus because it helps with attendance. Combining with
 student events helps too.
- An idea was presented to Human Resources about giving staff paid time off to help with service on campus. Unfortunately, this idea was not widely accepted.
- The board suggested having her send out a schedule of projects so that staff could make plans to participate in advance.

Dixie Development Day - Ali Threet

 Ali felt that everything went well this year. She suggested keeping a virtual option in combination with face-to-face presentations. Jon has all of her feedback. He mentioned that next year, we will most likely need to change the name of the event.

Compensation – Jon Gibb

 Jon wants to continue working with Human Resources regarding procedures affecting compensation. We need to be aware of new policies and policy changes. Also, staff need to be aware of what their benefits are here because there is more than just a paycheck. This information would be beneficial for new employees too.

Policy Steering – Rose Hill

• Rose mentioned that we really don't have any control over policies; however, it is very helpful for staff to be aware of what is coming up and to provide feedback.
